
VA STEMI Process for UW Cath Lab Activations

UW Cath Lab staff will call for patient when they are ready for transport. Please do not transport patient prior to the Cath lab calling for them.

VA staff transports patient to UW Cath Lab **Bring copy of STEMI Handoff form & ECG (Bring Cell Phone)

VA staff arranges for VA ICU Bed and Calls UW Cath Lab Charge phone with room information 513-8562

At UW, VA RN gives handoff & copies of STEMI handoff & ECG to UW Cath Lab RN.

> Cath Lab Nurse assumes responsibility for the patient and patient undergoes the procedure

If patient does not need a ICU bed or needs to stay at UW, Cath Lab CVT will call 308-3463 to notify them of the change in bed status. This # will forward to AOD on off-tours

UW Cath lab is located at F6/3, (F module on the 3rd Floor). Enter through the PACU Corridor. Use telephone on the wall to gain access.

Please ask UW Cath Lab staff to let VA Staff out of area after handoff.
